Her research interests lie in metabolic disturbance, intracellular degradative system, cognitive function, immunity, neurological/neurodegenerative diseases and metabolic diseases. She has a background in diverse areas of brain neuroscience, in particular, the role of inflammatory response and cognitive function. Currently, her lab has been studying the metabolic encephalopathy, focusing on inflammatory response, cognitive function, and metabolic abnormalities. Her research focuses on elucidating biological and mechanistic aspects of these diseases. Her work has been supported by the National Research Foundation of Korea (NRF) grant funded by the Korea government.
