Lee-Ling Lim (University Malaya Medical Centre, Malaysia)

Dr. Lim is a Consultant Endocrinologist and Head of the Diabetes Care Unit, University of Malaya Medical Centre, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia. As a clinician-scientist, Dr. Lim's major areas of interest are cardiometabolic medicine with translational and implementation science components.

She sits on the Scientific Work Groups of the American Diabetes Association/European Association for the Study of Diabetes Precision Medicine in Diabetes Initiative (ADA/EASD PMDI), the World Health Organization (WHO) Global Diabetes Compact, and The Lancet Commission on Diabetes, who provide authoritative resources in tackling the global epidemic of diabetes and related NCDs. She has published 100 peer-reviewed articles including high-impact journals e.g., The Lancet, Nature, Diabetes Care, and Science Bulletin.

Dr. Lim has received several awards including the World's Top 2% Scientists by Stanford University in 2022 and 2023. She is an Editorial Board Member of several Tier 1 Web of Science-indexed journals (BMC Medicine, Diabetes/Metabolism Research & Reviews, and Diabetes & Metabolism journal). She is also the Honorary Asst Secretary of the Malaysian Endocrine and Metabolic Society.
